FEEDBACK FROM PEOPLE WITH HAEMOPHILIA REQUIRED FOR RESEARCH PROJECT

If you would like to help make haemophilia questionnaires more suitable to Australians, then you might be interested in this research project!

What is Linguistic Validation?
